## APPRECIATING DIVERSITY IN WORSHIP

Acts 20:7-12 (KJV)

- I. Notice Three Types of Acceptable Praise In The Bible
  - A. Vocal Praise Psalm 95:1-2  
(The use of the human voice: Singing, Shouting, Speaking, etc.)
  - B. Audible Praise Psalm 150:3-6; Psalm 47:1  
(Praise with sounds other than human voice sounds: Musical Instruments, clapping of hands, etc.)
  - C. Body Language Praise Psalm 95:6; Psalm 63:4, 1 Timothy 2:8  
(Psalm 149:2-3)
  
- II. Three Main Components In Christian Worship (Acts 20:7)
  - A. Celebrate “the first day of the week”
  - B. Reverence “came together to break bread”
  - C. Instruction “Paul preached unto them”
  
- III. Five Observations Regarding Christian Worship
  - A. We should not make worship services a test of fellowship.
  - B. We should not judge one another based on which Worship Style one prefers.
  - C. We need to be careful lest we end up worshiping a particular worship style.
  - D. Allow for diversity in worship.
  - E. Body language praise is not the primary focus in Christian Worship.
